### EXECUTIVE ORDER

#### Full and Unconditional Pardon Jay R. Bieseimeier

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, Jared Polis, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order granting a pardon to Jay R. Bieseimeier.

#### **I. Background**

In 2002, Jay R. Bieseimeier pleaded guilty to Controlled Substance - Possession Schedule IV and to Controlled Substance - Possess Chemical/Supplies to Manufacture – Schedule II in Jefferson County, Colorado (2002CR981 and 2003CR145). In 2003, Jay R. Bieseimeier pleaded guilty to Controlled Substance - Possess Schedule II – Over 1 G in Larimer County, Colorado (2003CR1889). Jay R. Bieseimeier completed the terms of his sentences. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this pardon is in the interest of justice.

#### **II. Grant of Clemency**

- A. Jay R. Bieseimeier be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described convictions.
- B. All of his rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of his civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with these convictions are removed.
