EXECUTIVE ORDER

Commutation of Sentence and Full and Unconditional Pardon Jay F. Hemphill

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, Jared Polis, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order commuting the sentence of and granting a pardon to Jay F. Hemphill.

I. Background

In 2022, Jay F. Hemphill, pleaded guilty to Misdemeanor Menacing in Denver County, Colorado (2021CR5389). He was sentenced to one year unsupervised probation. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied and granting this commutation and pardon is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Jay F. Hemphill be and hereby is granted a full commutation, such that his sentence is terminated immediately.
- B. Jay F. Hemphill be and hereby is granted a full and unconditional pardon of the above described conviction.
- C. All of his rights of citizenship, including but not limited to, voting, jury duty, holding public office, and firearms privileges, are restored in full without condition. All of his civil disabilities and public sufferings associated with this conviction are removed.
