EXECUTIVE ORDER

**Commutation of Sentence
Victor A. Clark**

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, Jared Polis, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order commuting the sentence of Victor A. Clark.

I. Background

In 2012, Victor A Clark, DOC Reg. No. 156805, was convicted of Aggravated Robbery - Possess Real/Simulated Weapon (five counts); Aggravated Robbery - Possess Real/Simulated Weapon - Conspiracy; Tampering with Victim/Witness (2010CR3663). He was sentenced to the Department of Corrections for 66 years for these crimes. He has a current estimated parole eligibility date in 2051. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this commutation is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Victor A. Clark be and hereby is granted a limited commutation such that he shall be parole eligible on January 15, 2030.
- B. This grant of clemency is limited to making Victor A. Clark parole eligible on January 15, 2030, and shall not in any way affect the underlying criminal sentence.
