EXECUTIVE ORDER

**Commutation of Sentence
Travis B. Colvin**

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Governor of the State of Colorado by Article IV, Section 7 of the Colorado Constitution, I, Jared Polis, Governor of the State of Colorado, hereby issue this Executive Order commuting the sentence of Travis B. Colvin.

I. Background

In 1988, Travis B. Colvin was convicted of Sexual Assault 1st Degree; Criminal Attempt - 1st Degree Murder; Aggravated Motor Vehicle Theft Greater Than \$15000; Aggravated Robbery; 1st Degree Assault; 1st Degree Burglary; and 3rd Degree Assault (1987CR208). He was sentenced to the Department of Corrections for 154 years for these crimes. He has a current estimated parole eligibility date in 2045. The constitutional and statutory conditions for granting this clemency petition have been satisfied, and granting this commutation is in the interest of justice.

II. Grant of Clemency

- A. Travis B. Colvin be and hereby is granted a limited commutation such that he shall be parole eligible on January 15, 2028.
- B. This grant of clemency is limited to making Travis B. Colvin parole eligible on January 15, 2028, and shall not in any way affect the underlying criminal sentence.
