The Colorado PTAC is a non-profit corporation that receives funding from the State of Colorado both from state funds and a federal grant that the state receives and subcontracts to the PTAC. The PTAC provides free specialized and professional technical assistance to individuals and businesses that are seeking to pursue and successfully perform under contracting and subcontracting opportunities with DOD, other federal agencies, and/or state and local governments. This specialized and professional assistance may consist of, but is not limited to outreach and counseling type services. The PTAC makes a concerted effort to seek out and assist Small Businesses, Small Disadvantaged Businesses (SDB), Women-Owned Small Businesses (WOSB), Historically Underutilized Business Zone (HUBZone) Small Business Concerns, Servicedisabled Veteran-owned Small Businesses, and Historically Black Colleges and Minority Institutions (HBCU/MIs).
