## Pueblo Regional Tourism Zone

- The Pueblo Urban Renewal Authority received \$1,107,545.86 of state sales tax increment diverted revenue for the twelve months ending April 30, 2015 as a result of the act.
- The actual sales tax revenue collected within the zone for the same period was \$43,307,323.55.

## **Colorado Springs Regional Tourism Zone**

- The Colorado Springs Urban Renewal Authority received \$760,632.07 of state sales tax increment diverted revenue for the twelve months ending November 30, 2014 as a result of the act.
- The actual sales tax revenue collected within the zone for the same period was \$175,318,407.57.
