# Go NoCO Regional Tourism Zone Maps





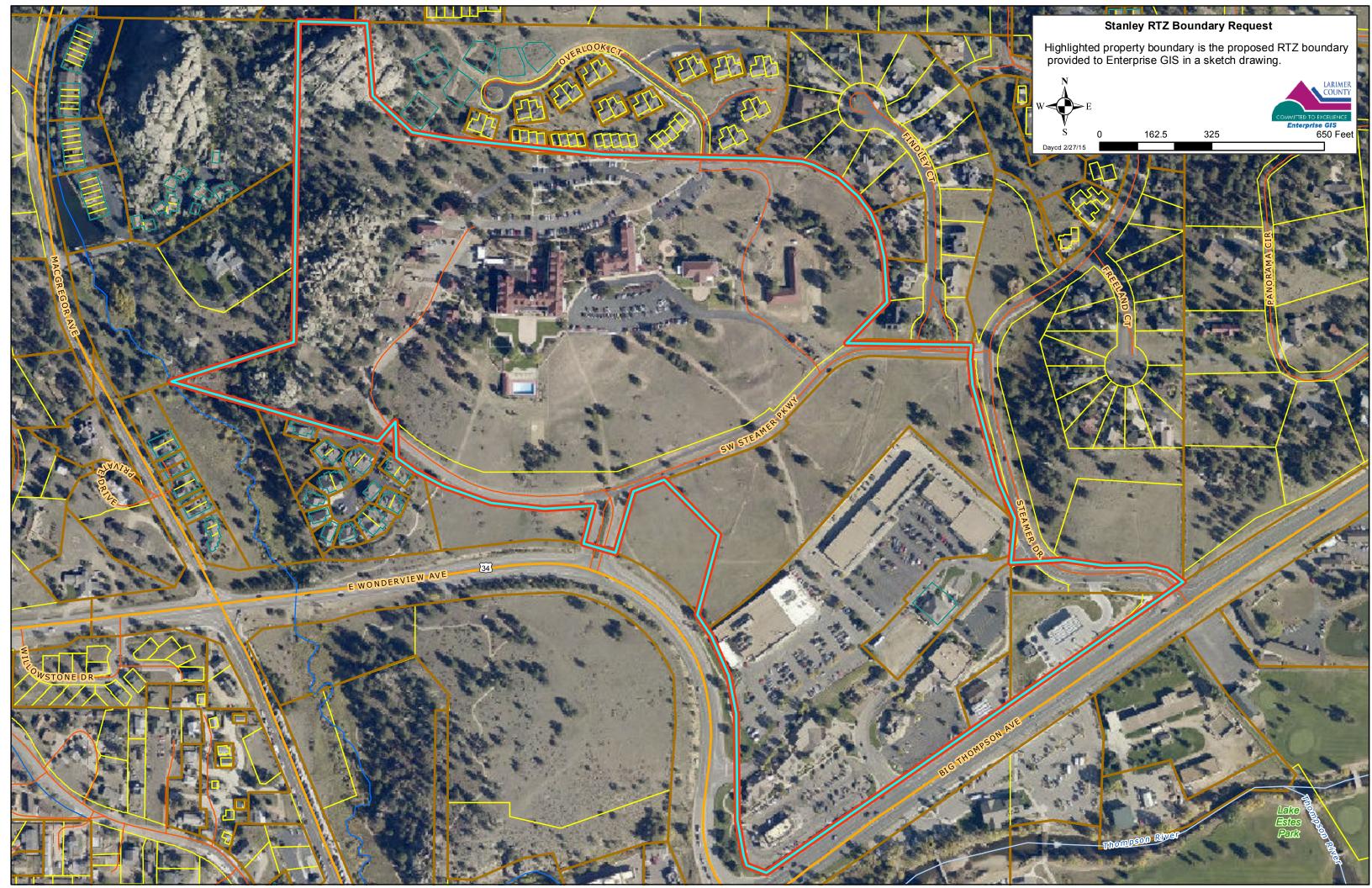




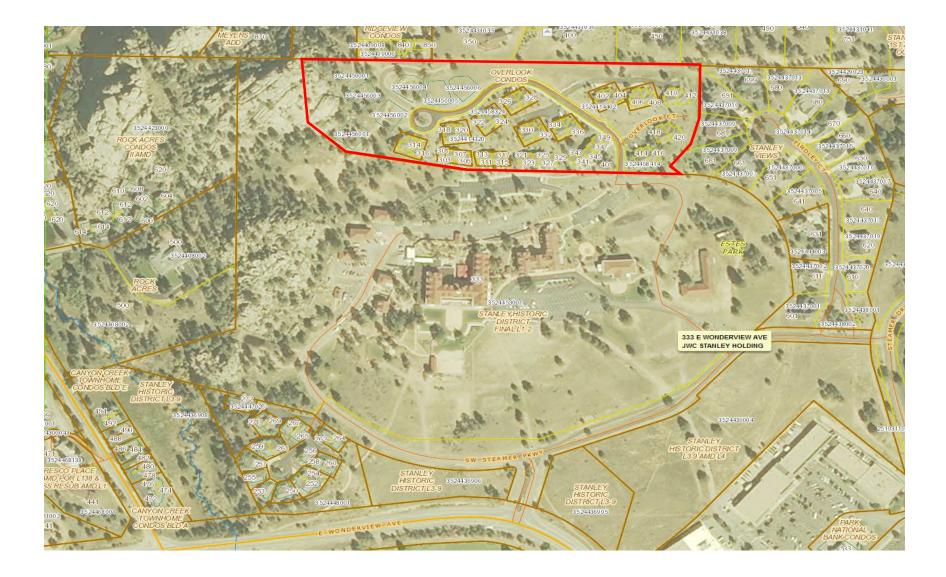








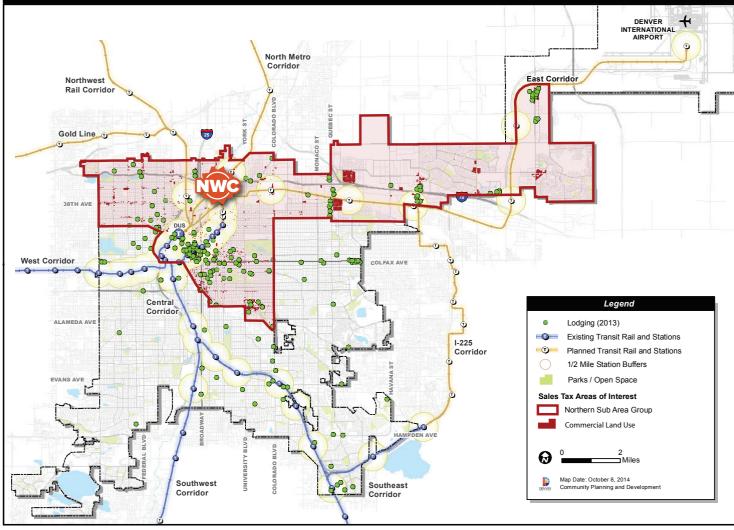






National Western Center **Regional Tourism Zone** Map R Net New Jobs by CDLE Category
