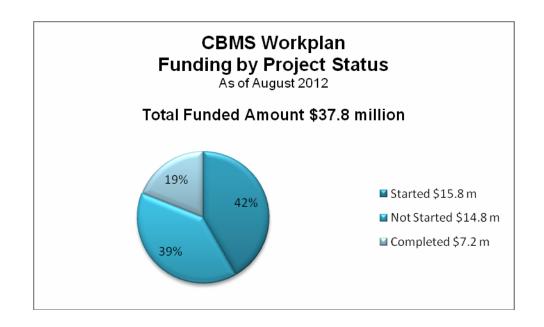

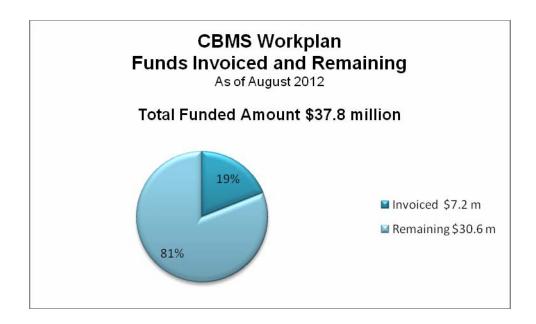
Project Highlights

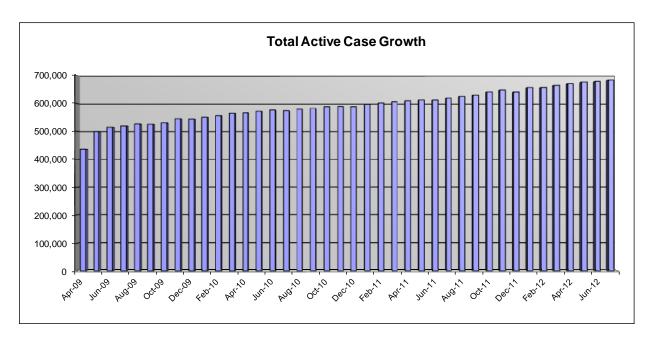
- CBMS presented 93 priorities to the JBC, which at that time included 102 projects. 37 of those original 102 projects have been completed. CBMS has defined an additional 32 subprojects which will play a role in completing the remaining priorities.
- With total funding of \$37,781,435, the Workplan budget is on track with \$7,178, 410 invoiced thus far (see graphics, page 2).
- *Performance of the benefits system* increased over the past quarter, and as of August 18, 2012 the system is slightly above the 90 percent mark of all transactions completed in less than 4 seconds (see graphic, page 3).
- **Timeliness of benefits** hovers around the 90 percent mark (see graphics, page 4).
- <u>www.cbmscolorado.com</u> is a new website containing information on the CBMS modernization project, including documents submitted to the JBC.

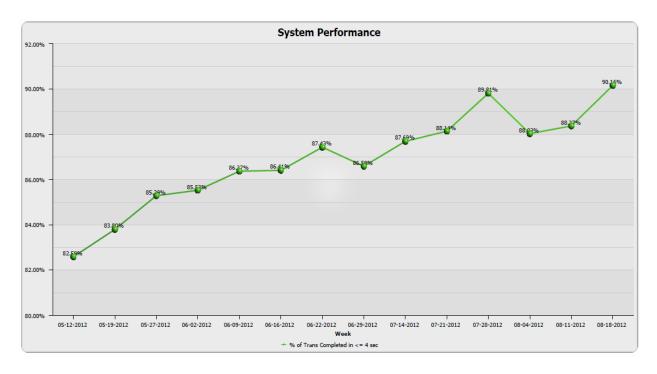

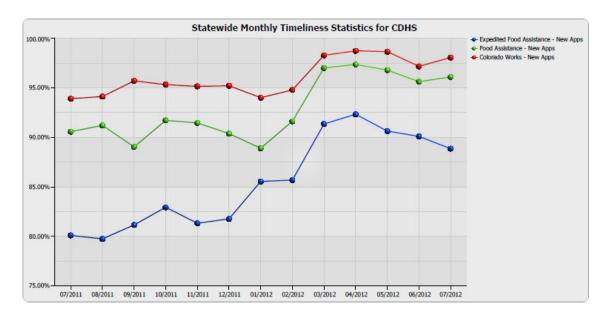




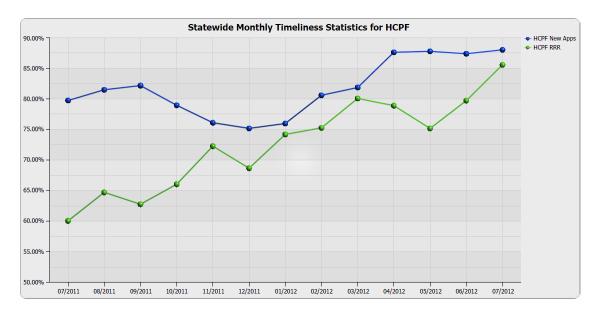
The above graphic shows monthly caseload growth over the past 3 years.

Projects Completed or Scheduled to Complete - 49 Projects In Progress - 36 Projects Starting Next Qtr – 49 (est.)

Highlighted accomplishments this reporting period

PROJ 1944, Medicaid Buy-In Program-Children with Disabilities

As part of the June 2012 CBMS production release, the Medicaid Buy-In Program for Children with Disabilities (Children's Buy-In) was implemented. The Children's Buy-In is a Family Medical Assistance program that provides Medicaid benefits for children with disabilities whose adjusted family income is at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). Eligible families receive Medicaid benefits for their child with a disability by paying a monthly premium on a sliding scale based on their adjusted income.

The successful implementation of this project marks the completion of all projects associated with priority number 37(HB09-1293) on the CBMS Work Plan.

PROJ 2934, Correct Invalid Claims Resulting From Cash Program Approval

A change was made to reduce the number of Food Assistance claims/discrepancies that are created when a cash benefit is approved for months that the household already received Food Assistance. This will reduce the complexity of processing cases and avoid unnecessarily penalizing the recipients by asking them to pay back Food Assistance benefits for previous months.

Plans for Next Quarter

The initial phase of work related to priority number 18 will lay the groundwork for significant client benefit and cost reduction.

Proj. 3211 is a sub-project for the master project 3242 - CBMS Client Notice Redesign Implementation (Master Project). Proj. 3211 lays the foundation for the system redesign by providing the following benefits:

- * Ease of maintenance of client correspondence by state staff.
- * Enables streamlining the process of migration of Client Correspondence assets from one environment to another.
- * Enhances Form design capability as supported by Adobe LiveCycle.
- * Allows usage of *Adobe LiveCycle* functionality to build complex correspondences without much coding.

After the implementation of 3211, other sub-projects to 3242 will be implemented, such as:

- * Redesign RRR cover packet
- * Redesign and standardize Notice Of Actions
- * Send dependent correspondences as attachment to original Notice Of Actions
- * Allow clients to access their correspondences through an inbox in PEAK
- * Send e-notification to clients via text messages or emails

Community Voices

"Having the option to utilize an online application for clients has been very successful for our organization. The stress is taken away from the clients from having to walk into the a human services office and wait long periods of times to do the same process they can do online in a shorter amount of time." – CBMS County Worker, Boulder

"My observations about the current system are the following from the perspective of a community-based PE Site:

- 1. Faster response time for the system.
- 2. The ability to increase font size a real blessing for your eyes
- 3. More data is available on a given page
- 4. Downside --- the number of bulletins that the system sends out that may/may not be of value to all users.

"Working directly with people utilizing the PEAK website, I have witnessed their relief at having the option to apply for benefits from anywhere with an Internet connection. Recently, I spoke with a woman who told me about the difficulties she experienced trying to find the time to visit her county office to apply for the Food Assistance Program. Working full-time as well as caring for her 2 small children prevented her from making it to the office within regular business hours. When she found out about PEAK, she was able to set up an account and submit her application from the privacy of her home. She said it was great to be able to apply on her own time, under her own roof. Such positive feedback regarding the convenience and user-friendliness of PEAK has been consistent throughout my experience in conducting SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) outreach."
