

The purpose of this change form is to highlight revisions to the Uniform Service Coding Standards (USCS) Manual.

Acronyms were allowed to stand for each word throughout the manual (HCPF, BH, OBH, etc.)	This made the usage consistent throughout the manual and removed the redundancy of having the word (abv) each time.
Changed "Substance Abuse" to "Substance Use" throughout manual where appropriate (Not in names or purposeful titles, i.e. SAMHSA, etc.)	To reflect current best practice
Added "COMPASS Rules Manual" to "CCAR Manual" per OBH practice	This addresses the upcoming transition to COMPASS
Corrected CCAR acronym	Change error
All references to Division of Youth Corrections (DYC) have been changed to (DYS) "Services"	Change error
Deleted 2 bullet points under first paragraph in section IV. Provider Type	To remove information that was creating confusion instead of providing clarity.
Edit section X.b. Colorado HCPF Procedure Code Revisions	These instructions are obsolete now that HCPF manages the Coding Manual. Changed to direct comments to the RAE
Delete Time-Based increments description under "Unit" bullet on page 44	Remove redundancy - Section IX is exclusively about Time Documentation Rules
Delete "Procedure Code Page Outline" section under section I.b. Manual Format on page 9	Remove redundancy - Section VIII is exclusively about Procedure Code Outline
Delete Appendix A and related comments under Section I.b	This was obsolete information related to IT systems/infrastructure.
Added 90785 to Appendix J, E&M Add-on Codes	To reflect the way this code is used consistently with the other add-on codes
