2001 - Winter/Spring Denver & Statewide Provider Billing Workshop Schedule

Provider billing workshops include both Medicaid billing instructions and a review of Medicaid billing procedures. Workshops are intended for both new and experienced Medicaid billers. Provider representatives explain and discuss Medicaid program policies, billing requirements, and problem-solving strategies.

The Winter/Spring workshops begin in January 2001 and continue through June 2001. Both the Denver workshops and the Statewide workshops are listed in this bulletin. All workshops cover the same topics. Topics may vary from previous workshops.

If you are interested in a billing topic that is not listed, it may be offered during the 2001 Summer/Fall Denver or Statewide workshops. These workshop schedules will be published in a future Medicaid bulletin.

Denver parking

Workshops are conducted at the fiscal agent's office, in the Dominion Plaza Building at 600 17th Street, the 6th floor in the North Tower of the building. Parking is **not** provided and is limited in the Downtown Denver area. Providers attending workshops are urged to carpool and arrive early to secure parking or to use public transportation.

Commercial parking lots are available throughout the downtown area and the daily rates range from approximately \$5 to \$10. Most of the city parking meters are limited to one or two hours. The following map indicates the parking lots near Dominion Plaza. There is additional parking near Union Station, Market Street Station, and Civic Center Station. Providers who park in these areas should take the 16th Street Mall Shuttle to Welton Street.


Driving directions

Take Interstate 25 to Exit 210A – Colfax. Go east.

Take Colfax 0.8 miles to Welton – seventh light. Go north.

Take Welton 0.4 miles to 16th Street – Third light.

Consultec is located in the Dominion Plaza, on the west side of Welton, between 16th and 17th Streets.
