#### **Request Summary:**

The Department of Higher Education requests a supplemental for \$11,020,202 total funds/reappropriated funds for FY 2011-12. This request is a technical correction to the appropriation to comply with HB11-1074.

Senate Bill 10-003 authorized a direct General Fund appropriation to the Colorado School of Mines equal to what they would receive through a fee-for-service contract. This funding was to be used for an institutional financial aid program. The FY 2011-12 Long Bill (SB11-209) appropriated the \$11,020,202 General Fund directly to the Colorado School of Mines consistent with the provisions of SB10-003.

However, HB11-1074 provided that the Colorado School of Mines receive a fee-for-service contract appropriation, starting in FY 2011-12. This legislation provided that the Colorado School of Mines would allocate, over time, a portion of this amount to institutional financial aid. While the financing change was authorized by HB11-1074, the associated change to the appropriation was neither incorporated in the bill's appropriations clause nor in the FY 2011-12 Long Bill (SB11-209).

This technical request seeks to correct the FY 2011-12 appropriation by transferring

\$11,020,202 General Fund from the Colorado School of Mines appropriation to the College Opportunity Fund Fee-for-Service Contracts line item. This same \$11,020,202 is then transferred via reappropriated funds to the Colorado School of Mines.

#### **Anticipated Outcomes:**

This supplemental request brings the appropriation for the Colorado School of Mines into compliance with current law pursuant to HB 11-1074.

## **Current Statutory Authority or Needed Statutory Change:**

This request is necessary due to the passage of HB11-1074 which clarified how the funding for the Colorado School of Mines is budgeted and administered. Section 23-41-104.7 (1), C.R.S. specifies that the Colorado School of Mines will receive funding through a fee-for-service contract (reappropriated funds) instead of a direct General Fund appropriation. No further statutory change is necessary.
