S.B. 04-257 Amortization Equalization Disbursement	This appropriation reflects an increase to the effective PERA contribution rates beginning January 1, 2006 to bring the Department into compliance with 24-51-211 C.R.S. (2007).

S.B 18-200 PERA Direct Distribution	Provides additional funding to increase the state contribution for PERA.

Legal Services	Provides funding for the Department to purchase legal services from the Department of Law.	
Administrative Law Judge Services	Provides funding for the Department to purchase services from the Department of Personnel and Administration, Administrative Hearings Division.	
Payments to OIT	This line item, established by HB 14-1336, consolidates the Department's share of funding for the various services provided by OIT.	
CORE Operations	This line item provides funding for the operation and maintenance of the statewide accounting and budgeting system that replaced COFRS.	
Payment to Risk Management and Property Funds	Provides funding for the Department's share of the statewide cost of property and liability insurance coverage.	

Leased Space	Funding for lease payments for space at 1560 Broadway, Denver.
