

#### System Summary – Academic Year 2011 Degrees Awarded

In the academic year 2010-2011, 13,194 certificates and degrees were awarded at Colorado Community College System schools. This is a 7% increase from academic year 2010. The largest group of awards were 1-year certificates, at 43.1%, followed by Associate of Arts / Associate of Science degrees at 20.2%. Generally, Associate of General Studies and Associate of Arts / Associate of Science degrees are transfer-oriented awards, while Associate of Applied Science degrees are considered terminal awards.




Over the past five years, there has been a 36% increase in awards granted at Colorado Community College System colleges. The most significant increase has been in 1-year certificates with many people returning to college for retraining. Overall, 45% more certificates were awarded in academic year 2011 than in 2007.

Emergency Medical Services was the most awarded 1-year certificate, Criminal Justice / Police Science was the top 2-year certificate, and Registered Nursing the top Associate of Applied Science degree given. Due to programs imposing enrollment limitations based on clinical site availability there has been only a slight (1%) increase in the number of overall nursing degrees awarded, and a 6.1% decrease in the number of Registered Nursing degrees awarded. Part of the reason for the decrease in Registered Nursing degrees is due to the closure of a Registered Nursing program at one of our colleges.

Of all degrees awarded at any level (excluding liberal arts and general studies), the top program areas were Emergency Medical Services, Nursing Aide, Nursing, Automotive Technology, and Criminal Justice. Programs may be approved to be offered at different levels at different colleges, i.e. Emergency Medical Services. Students receiving Emergency Medical Services and criminal justice awards typically already have employment with fire, emergency service, and protective agencies, and are not looking to fill new openings in the workforce.

Of all degrees awarded (excluding liberal arts and general studies), 52% were in the healthcare field, compared to 53% in 2010. 56% of certificates were in the health science area, and 40% of Associate of Applied Science degrees.

#### **College Summary**

Front Range Community College awarded the greatest number of awards (24%), consistent with their larger enrollment. It was followed by Pikes Peak Community College (16%). Three other colleges each awarded 10% of the overall degree total (Arapahoe Community College, Pueblo Community College and Red Rocks Community College).
