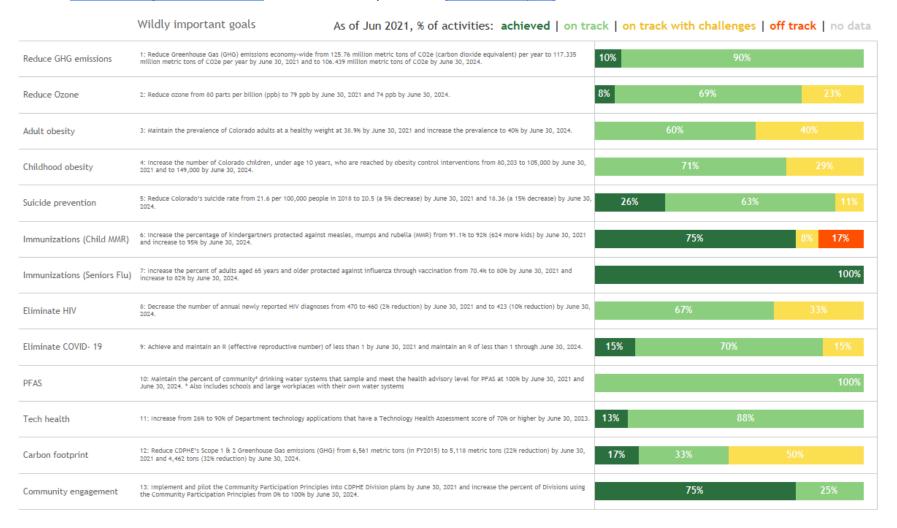




FY2021 Strategic Plan FINAL Status Report
