As a reminder to permittees: For permittees covered by the Light Industrial, Sand and Gravel, and Metal Mining general permits, **Annual Reports** covering January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006 are due to the Division office by **February 15, 2007**.

The Construction general permit will expire on June 30, 2007. The renewal applications were sent to the permittees in mid-February, and are due back in our office by March 31, 2007. The draft renewal permit was public noticed in December. Changes were made primarily to clarify Division intent on the permit requirements, and to add provisions for TMDLs. E. WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATIONS (Section 401)

Water Quality Certifications, under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act, provide for Division determinations that federally issued permits and licenses will comply with the Basic Standards and Methodologies for Surface Water, the Basic Standards for Ground Water, surface and ground water classifications and water quality standards, and all other applicable water quality requirements for the affected waters.

1. For the purposes of the antidegradation requirements found in Section 31.8 of the Basic Standards and Methodologies, the following projects have been reviewed to make a preliminary determination of the significance of such projects.
