E. WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATIONS (Section 401)

Water Quality Certifications, under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act, provide for Division determinations that federally issued permits and licenses will comply with the Basic Standards and Methodologies for Surface Water, the Basic Standards for Ground Water, surface and ground water classifications and water quality standards, and all other applicable water quality requirements for the affected waters.

 For the purposes of the antidegradation requirements found in Section 31.8 of the Basic Standards and Methodologies, the following projects have been reviewed to make a preliminary determination of the significance of such projects. Public comment on these preliminary determinations will be received for thirty days following the date of publication of this newsletter. Initial Stakeholder Meetings - Regulation No. 22, Site Location and Design Approval Regulations for Domestic Wastewater Treatment Works

The Water Quality Control Division will hold initial stakeholder meetings to identify issues in advance of the Water Quality Control Commission's May 12, 2008 Routine Review Informational Hearing (RRIH) for Regulation No. 22 (Site Location and Design Approval Regulations for Domestic Wastewater Treatment Works). The issues identified will be presented to the Water Quality Control Commission at the May 12, 2008 meeting. Following the RRIH, the issues identified will be evaluated through a formal stakeholder process in advance of a future Rulemaking Hearing for revisions to Regulation No. 22. Two initial stakeholder meetings will be held. The first meeting will occur on March 28, 2008, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The second meeting will occur on April 22, 2008, from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Both meetings will be conducted at the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, 4300 Cherry Creek Drive South, Denver, CO 80246.
