#### APPLICANT PERMIT ACTIVITY COUNTY WATERBODY DETERMINATIONS

The Division is issuing a **supplemental public notice** to review the NISP 401 application and draft certification (previously noticed in the March 2019 Water Quality Bulletin) as they **specifically relate** to the newly-issued *Clean Water Policy 12(CW-12)-Colorado Water Quality Selection of Best Management Practices*. #### This is a 30 day public comment period. Comments are due by close of business July 1<sup>st</sup>.

Please note there were no changes to the NISP 401 application from the March Public Notice. The Division will only accept comments on the NISP 401 application as they pertain to the new CW Policy 12. CW Policy 12 provides guidance for choosing appropriate BMPs for erosion and sediment control measures per Section 82.6(B). Comments not related to erosion and sediment control or CW Policy 12 will not be accepted.

#### D. WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATIONS (Section 401)

Water Quality Certifications, under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act, provide for Division determinations that federally issued permits and licenses will comply with the Basic Standards and Methodologies for Surface Water, the Basic Standards for Ground Water, surface and ground water classifications and water quality standards, and all other applicable water quality requirements for the affected waters.

1. For the purposes of the antidegradation requirements found in Section 31.8 of the Basic Standards and Methodologies, the following projects have been reviewed to make a preliminary determination of the significance of such projects and a draft certification determination. Public comment on these preliminary determinations will be received for thirty days following the date of publication of this newsletter.
