SPECIAL NOTES

The Integrated Water Quality Monitoring and Assessment Report, or the "Integrated Report" (IR) for 2020 summarizes water quality programs and data collected by state, federal, volunteer water monitoring organizations, and other sources. The IR includes the assessment status of monitored waterbodies according to their assigned water quality standards. This document integrates the reporting requirements of the Clean Water Act sections 303(d), 305(b), and section 314 which require jurisdictions to report to EPA biannually on the conditions of waters within their boundaries. NOTICE OF PHOSPHORUS TRADE APPLICATION SENT TO PUBLIC NOTICE ON JANUARY 30, 2020. COMMENTS DUE BY FEBRUARY 28, 2020

Regulation No. 73 Chatfield Reservoir Control Regulation requires new point source wastewater facilities proposed in the Chatfield Watershed to apply for a phosphorus wasteload allocation. The phosphorus allocation may be derived from a nonpoint to point source trade. The Water Quality Control Division is reviewing a trade application from Sun Jelly Larkspur CO RV LLC for a nonpoint source to point source trade for a total phosphorus allocation for a new discharge, the Jellystone Park at Larkspur WWTF. The Chatfield Watershed Authority conditionally approved the trade in November 2019. The division has completed an initial review and will render a final decision following this notice. Approval of the trade will provide Sun Jelly with a wasteload allocation under the control regulation which will enable Sun Jelly to apply for Permit Effluent Limits (PELS).

Purpose of Public Notice: To solicit public comment on the proposed nonpoint source to point source phosphorus trade application from Sun Jelly Larkspur CO RV LLC.

Water Quality Certifications, under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act, provide for Division determinations that federally issued permits and licenses will comply with the Basic Standards and Methodologies for Surface Water, the Basic Standards for Ground Water, surface and ground water classifications and water quality standards, and all other applicable water quality requirements for the affected waters.

1. For the purposes of the antidegradation requirements found in Section 31.8 of the Basic Standards and Methodologies, the following projects have been reviewed to make a preliminary determination of the significance of such projects and a draft certification determination.
