- Due by September 1, 2022
- Submit physical, biological, and chemical water quality data

- For waters protected by antidegradation designations, the Water Quality Control Division can determine that allowing more degraded water quality is necessary to accommodate important economic or social development and then give a discharger a more lenient "alternative" antidegradation limit. This is also called an "Antidegradation Alternative Analysis." WQCD is seeking public comment on draft guidance for submitting an application for an alternative antidegradation limit. - Policy CW 15, Clean Water Civil Penalty Policy The Water Quality Control Division noticed its intent to issue a revised Clean Water Civil Penalty Policy in April 2022. The Division received input from various stakeholders and made the following adjustments to the draft policy based on that input:
- Alternative Approach for Unpermitted Discharges when Site-Specific Discharge Data is Available the percent increase for unpermitted discharge was reduced from 75% to 50%.
- Category 1 Fault references to properly operating and maintaining the facility were removed and replaced with "violator could not *reasonably foresee or control* the circumstances leading to the violation."
- Days of Violation "or" was added to clarify that only one method of determining days of violation will be utilized for a particular violation.
- Minor editorial changes.

## D. WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATIONS (Section 401)

Water Quality Certifications, under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act, provide for Division determinations that federally issued permits and licenses will comply with the Basic Standards and Methodologies for Surface Water, the Basic Standards for Ground Water, surface and ground water classifications and water quality standards, and all other applicable water quality requirements for the affected waters.

 For the purposes of the antidegradation requirements found in Section 31.8 of the Basic Standards and Methodologies, the following projects have been reviewed to make a preliminary determination of the significance of such projects and a draft certification determination. Public comment on these preliminary determinations will be received for thirty days following the date of publication of this newsletter.
