

Motor Vehicle Death Rate 0-14
National Performance Measure 8

Healthy People 2010 Goal: Reduce the rate of deaths to children aged 0-14 caused by motor vehicle crashes to no more than 9.2 deaths per 100,000 children.

County rates are 1998-2000 three-year averages.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
