

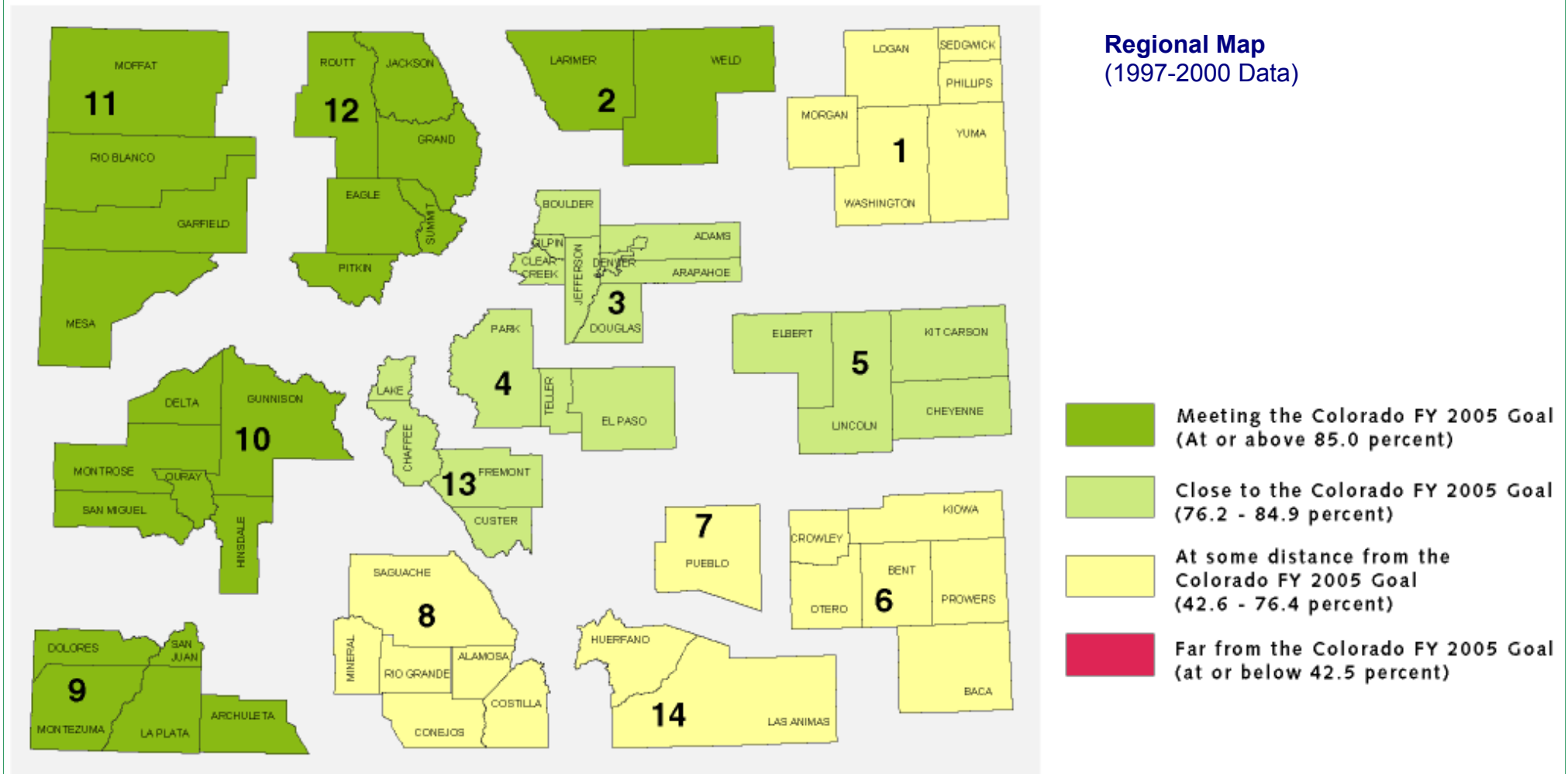

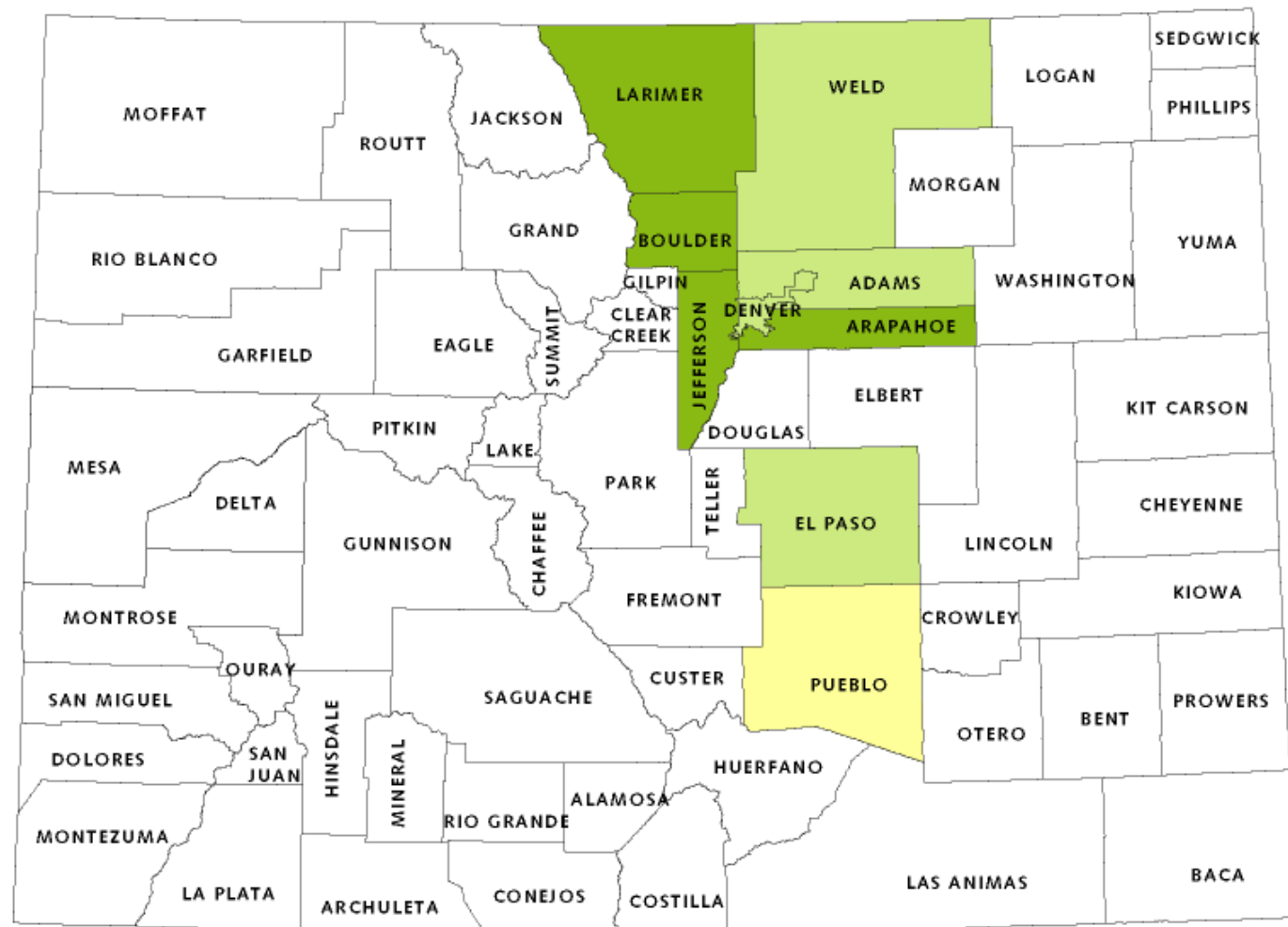
**Healthy People 2010 Goal:** *Increase the proportion of mothers who breastfeed their babies in the early postpartum period to 75%.*

**Colorado 2005 Goal:** *Increase the proportion of mothers who breastfeed their babies in the early postpartum period to 85%.*

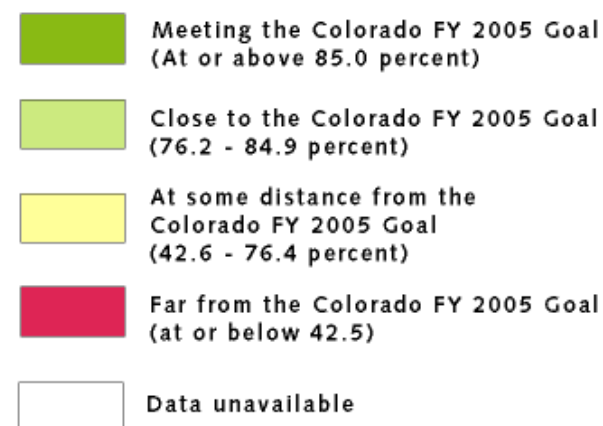
