
# Child Death Rate 1-14 National Outcome Measure 6

Healthy People 2010 Goal: Reduce the death rate of children to no more than 20.3 deaths per 100,000 children age 1-14.

County rates are 1997-2001 five-year averages.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
