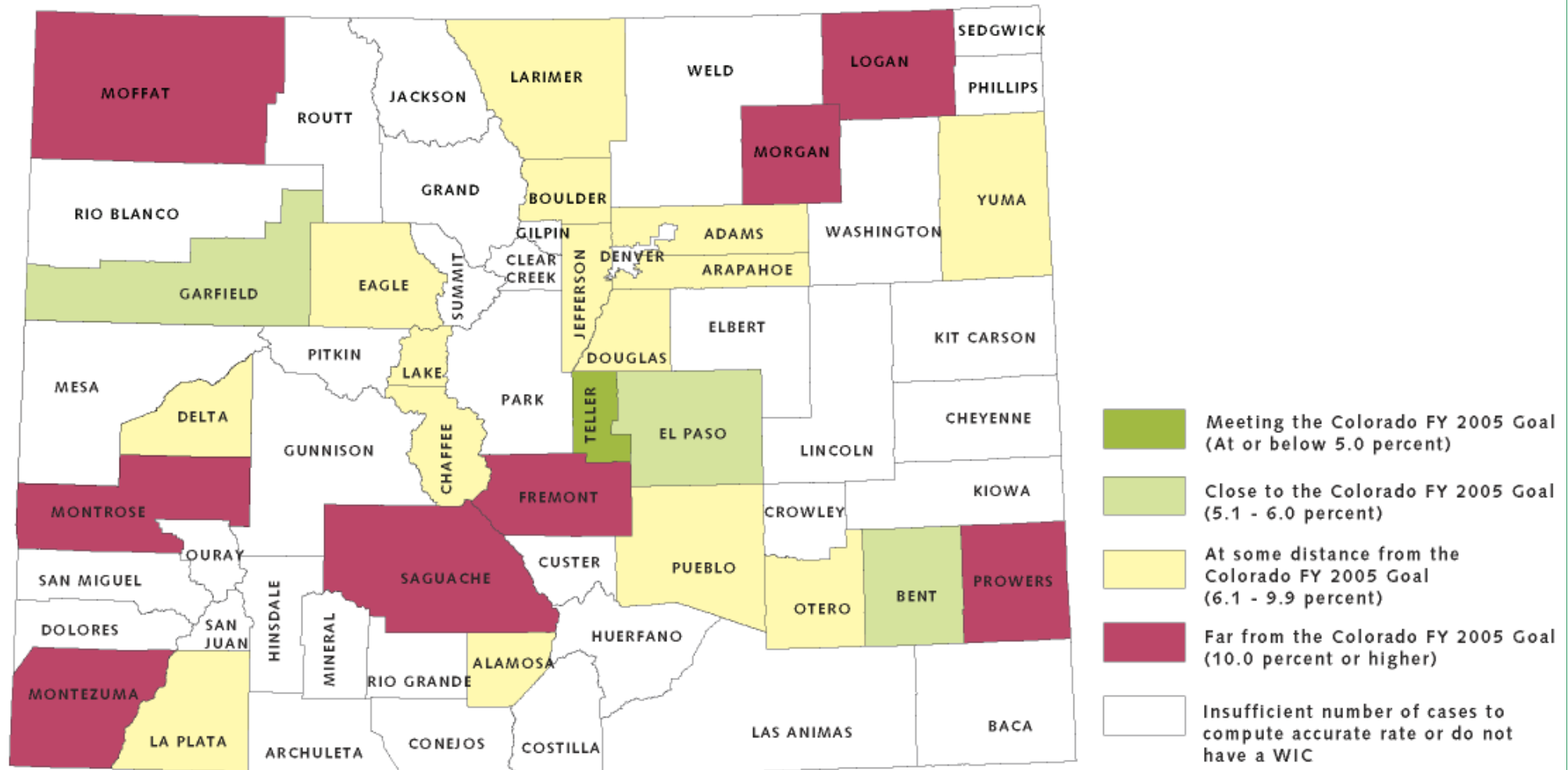


## Child Obesity Rate State Performance Measure 12

**Colorado FY 2005 Goal:** *Reduce the proportion of WIC children in Colorado who are obese to 5.0% or less.*

*County rates are based on 2001 WIC data.*

*Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.*
