
Newborn Hearing Screening Rate National Performance Measure 10

Colorado FY 2005 Goal: Increase the percent of infants whose hearing is screened for impairment before hospital discharge to 95.0%.

County rates are for the year 2001 and are compared to the Colorado FY 2005 goal.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 90 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are between 51 percent and 89 percent of the goal; and counties far from the goal are 50 percent or less of the desired goal.
