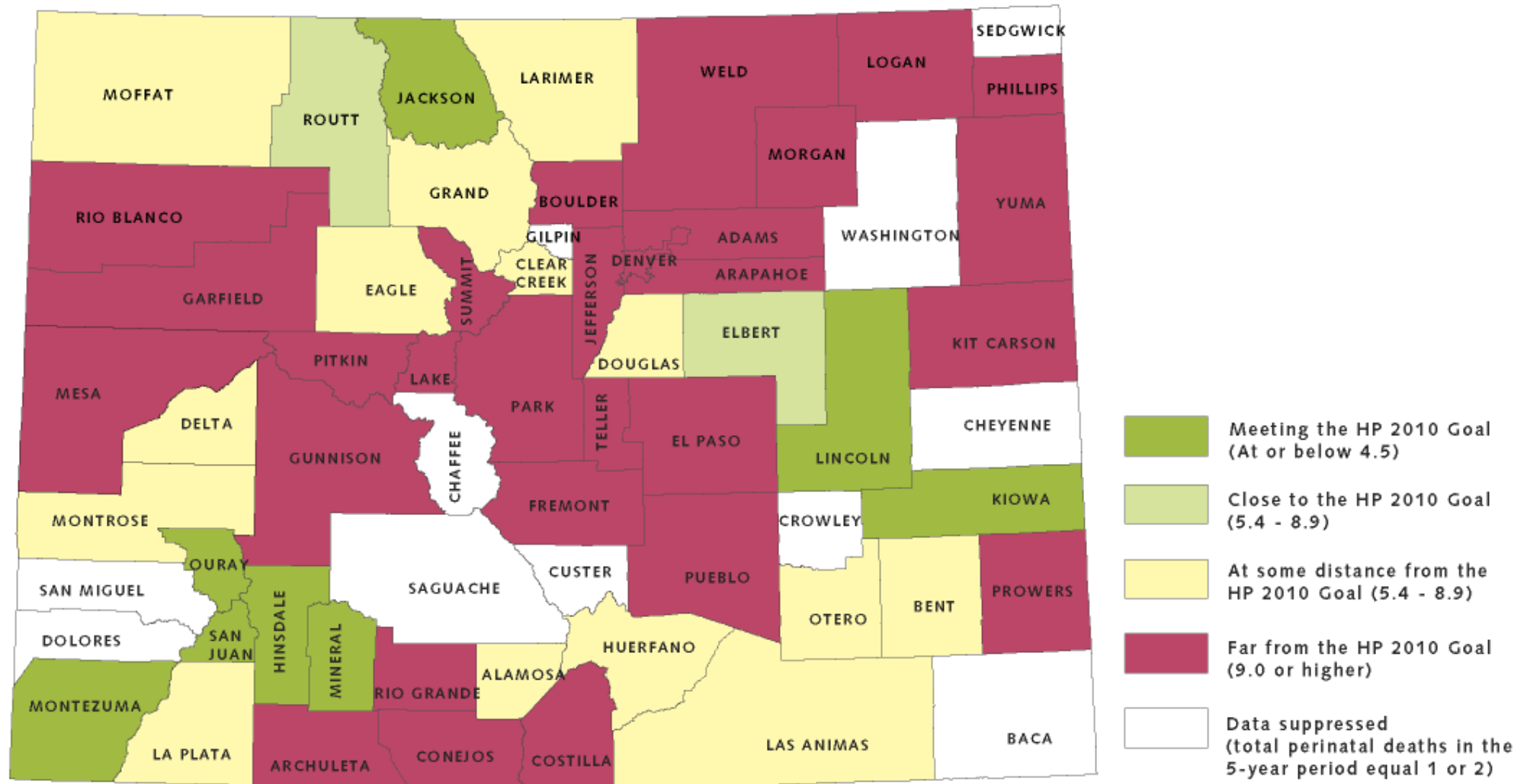


Perinatal Mortality Rate National Outcome Measure 5

Healthy People 2010 Goal: *Reduce the perinatal (neonatal plus fetal) mortality rate to no more than 4.5 deaths per 1,000 births.*

County rates are 1997-2001 five-year averages.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
