


## School-Based Health Care State Performance Measure 7

**Colorado FY 2005 Goal:** *Increase the proportion of children who have access to health services through school-based health centers to 8.75 percent statewide..*

*County rates are based on school data from Fall 2001. Comparisons refer to the Colorado FY 2005 goal.*

*Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 90 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are between 51 percent and 89 percent of the goal; and counties far from the goal are 50 percent or less of the desired goal.*
