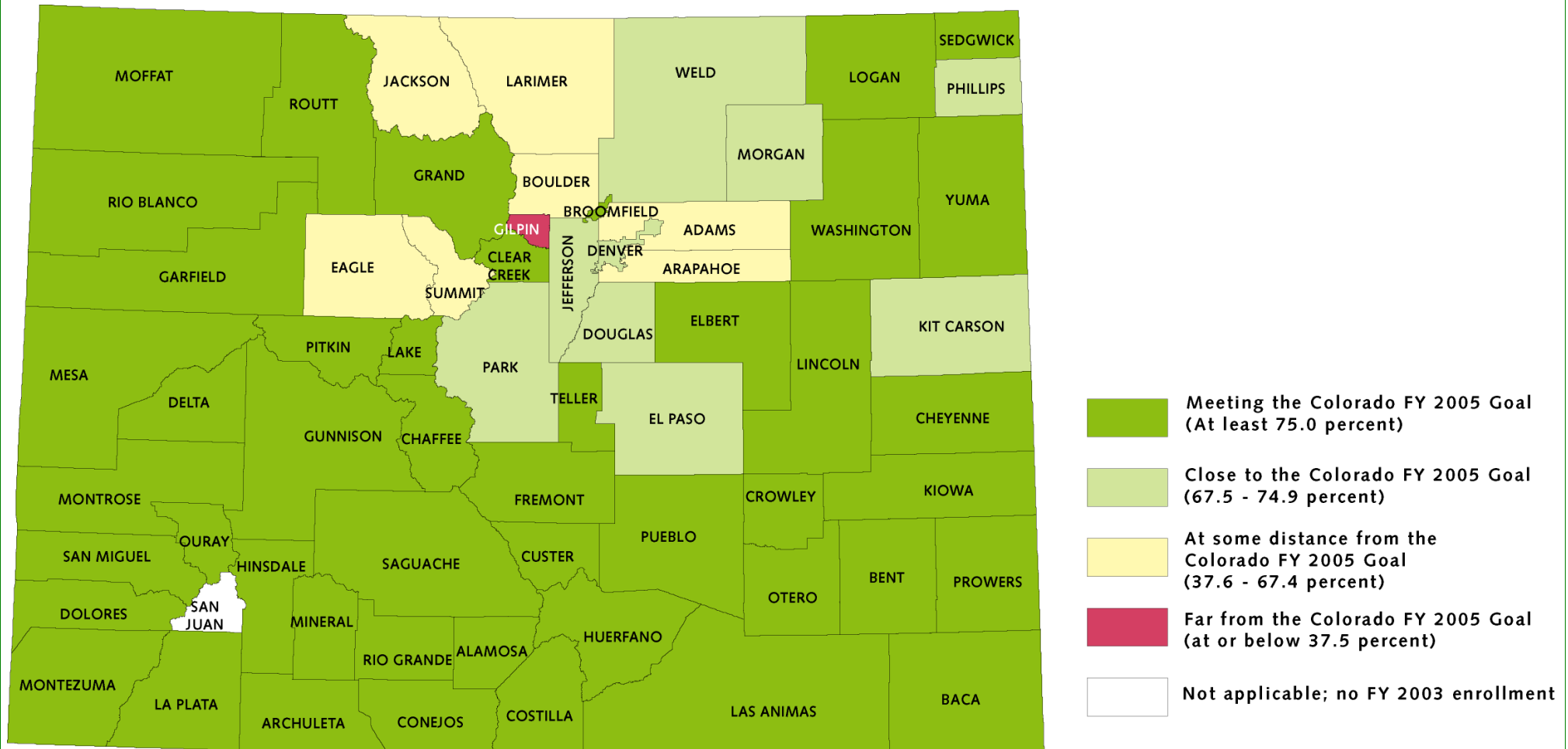


## HCP Insured Children National Performance Measure 11

**Colorado FY 2005 Goal:** *Increase the percent of children with special health care needs in the state Children with Special Health Care Needs program who have a source of insurance to 75 percent.*

*County rates are for fiscal year 2003. The Colorado rate is 74.4 percent.*

*Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 90 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are between 51 percent and 89 percent of the goal; and counties far from the goal are 50 percent or less of the desired goal.*
