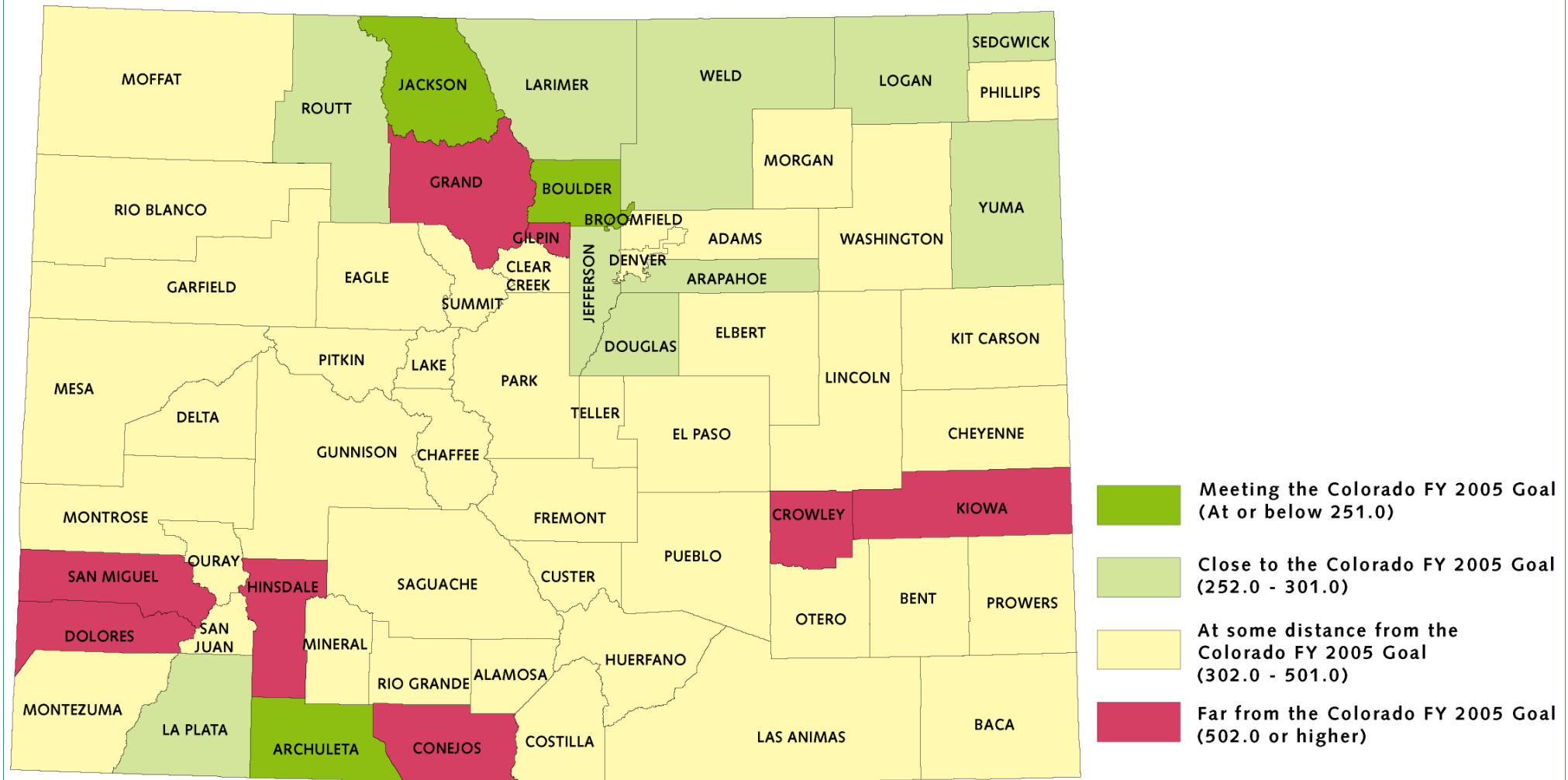


## Injury Hospitalization Rate State Performance Measure 14

**Colorado FY 2005 Goal:** *Reduce the rate of injury hospitalization among children age 19 and younger to 251.0 per 100,000.*

*County rates are 1998-2002 five-year averages. The Colorado rate is 321.5.*

*Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.*
