
## School-Based Health Care State Performance Measure 7

**Colorado FY 2005 Goal:** Increase the proportion of children who have access to health services through school-based health centers to 8.75 percent statewide.

County rates are based on school data from Fall 2002. Comparisons refer to the Colorado FY 2005 goal. The state rate is 7.6 percent.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 90 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are between 51 percent and 89 percent of the goal; and counties far from the goal are 50 percent or less of the desired goal.
