

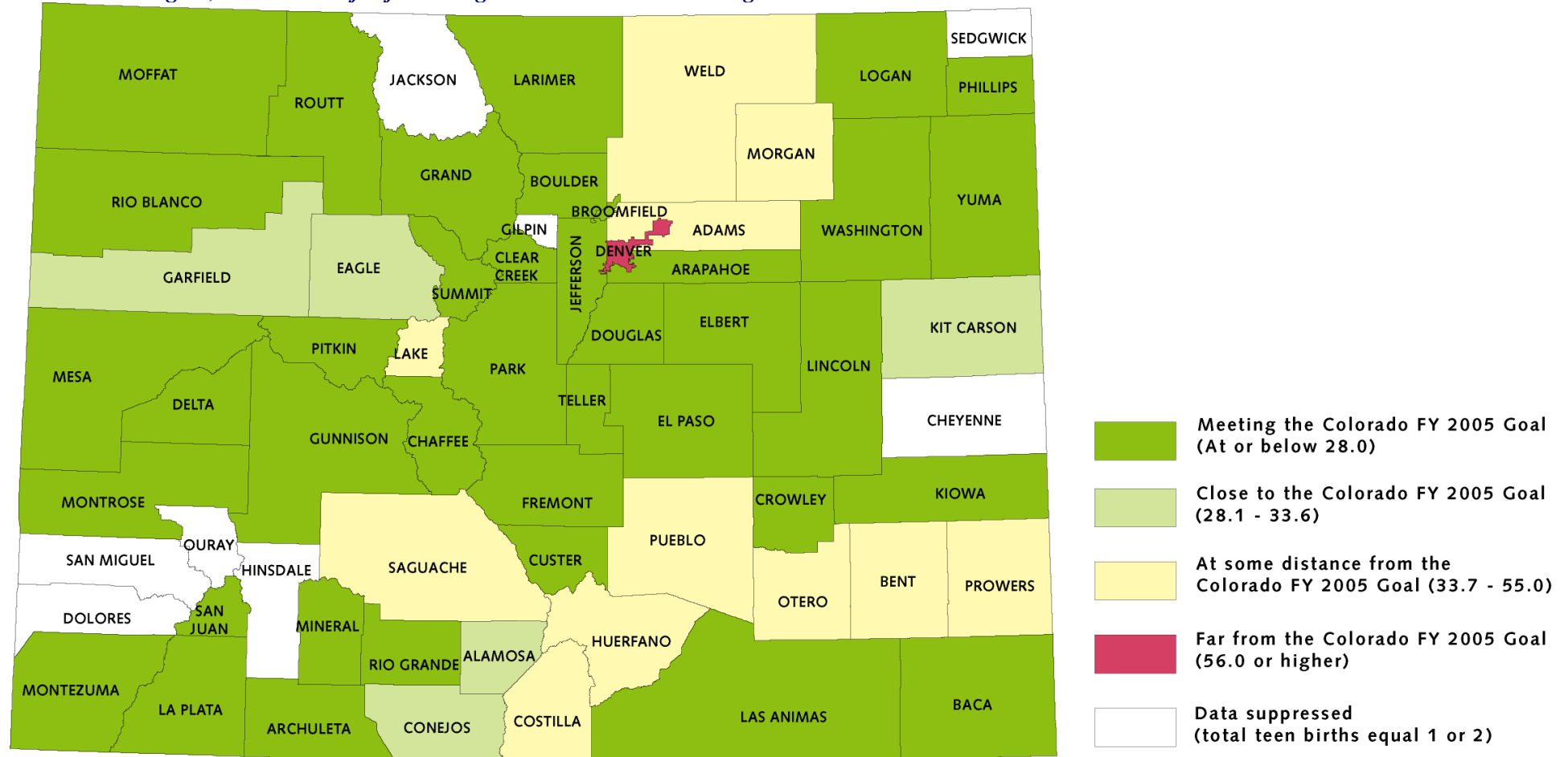
Teen Fertility Rate National Performance Measure 6

Healthy People 2010 Goal: *Reduce pregnancies among females age 15-17 to no more than 43 per 1,000 females.*

Colorado FY 2005 Goal: *Reduce the fertility rate among females age 15-17 to 28.0 births per 1,000 females.*
