
Child Obesity Rate State Performance Measure 12

Colorado FY 2005 Goal: Reduce the proportion of WIC children in Colorado who are obese to 5.0% or less.

County rates are based on 2003 WIC data. The Colorado rate is 9.4 percent.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
