

Dental Sealants Rate
National Performance Measure 9

Healthy People 2010 Goal: *Increase the proportion of children who have received dental sealants on their molar teeth to 50.0 percent.*

County rates are estimated for the year 2004 and are compared to the Healthy People 2010 Goal. The Colorado rate is 35.0 percent.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 80 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are at between 51 percent and 70 percent of the goal; and counties far from the goal are 50 percent or less of the desired goal.
