

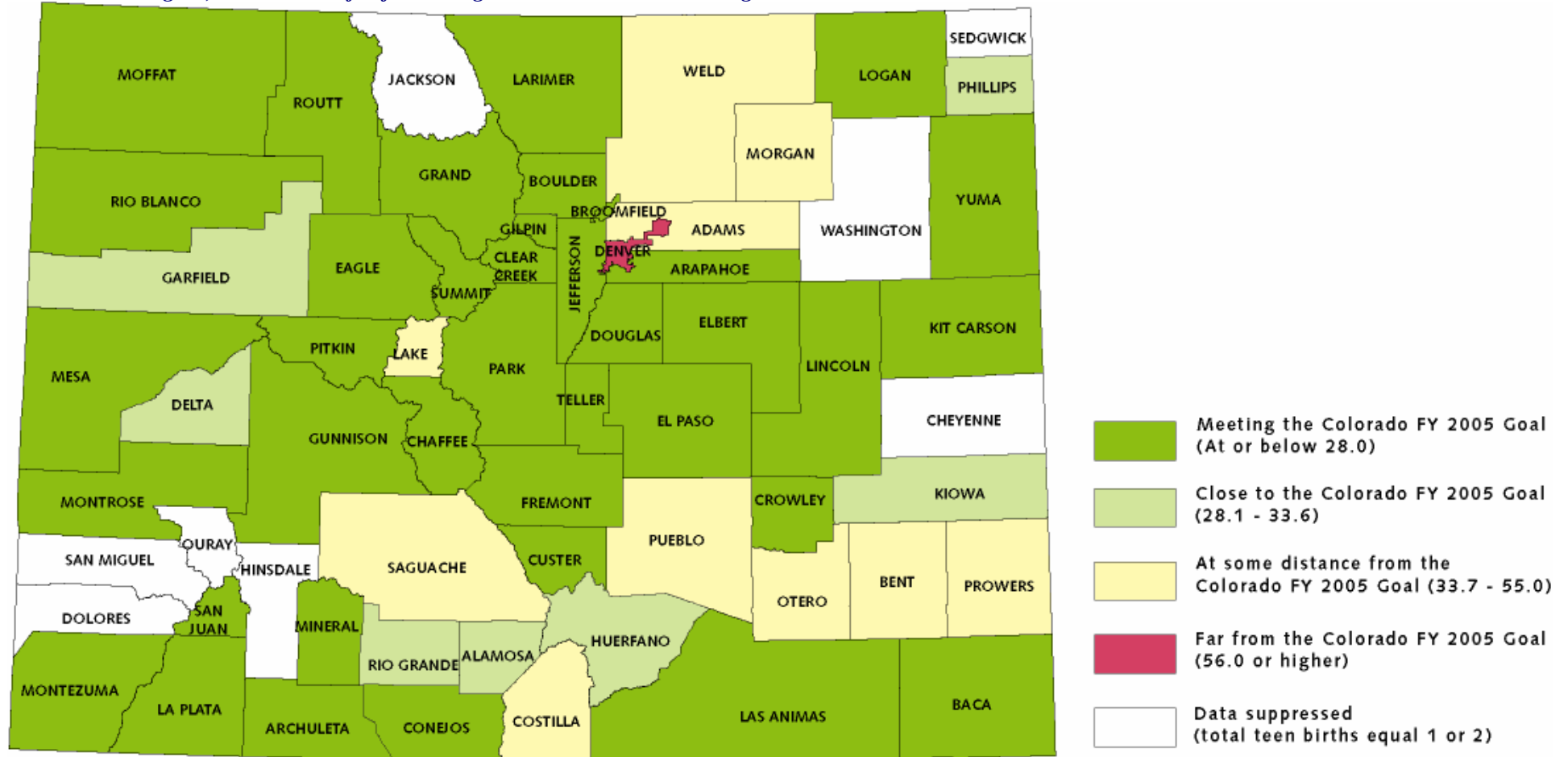
Teen Fertility Rate National Performance Measure 6

Healthy People 2010 Goal: *Reduce pregnancies among females age 15-17 to no more than 43 per 1,000 females.*

Colorado FY 2005 Goal: *Reduce the fertility rate among females age 15-17 to 28.0 births per 1,000 females.*

County rates are for 2001-2003 three-year averages, except for Broomfield which is 2002-2003 only. The state rate is 25.2. County comparisons are shown for the Colorado FY 2005 goal.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are double the desired goal.
