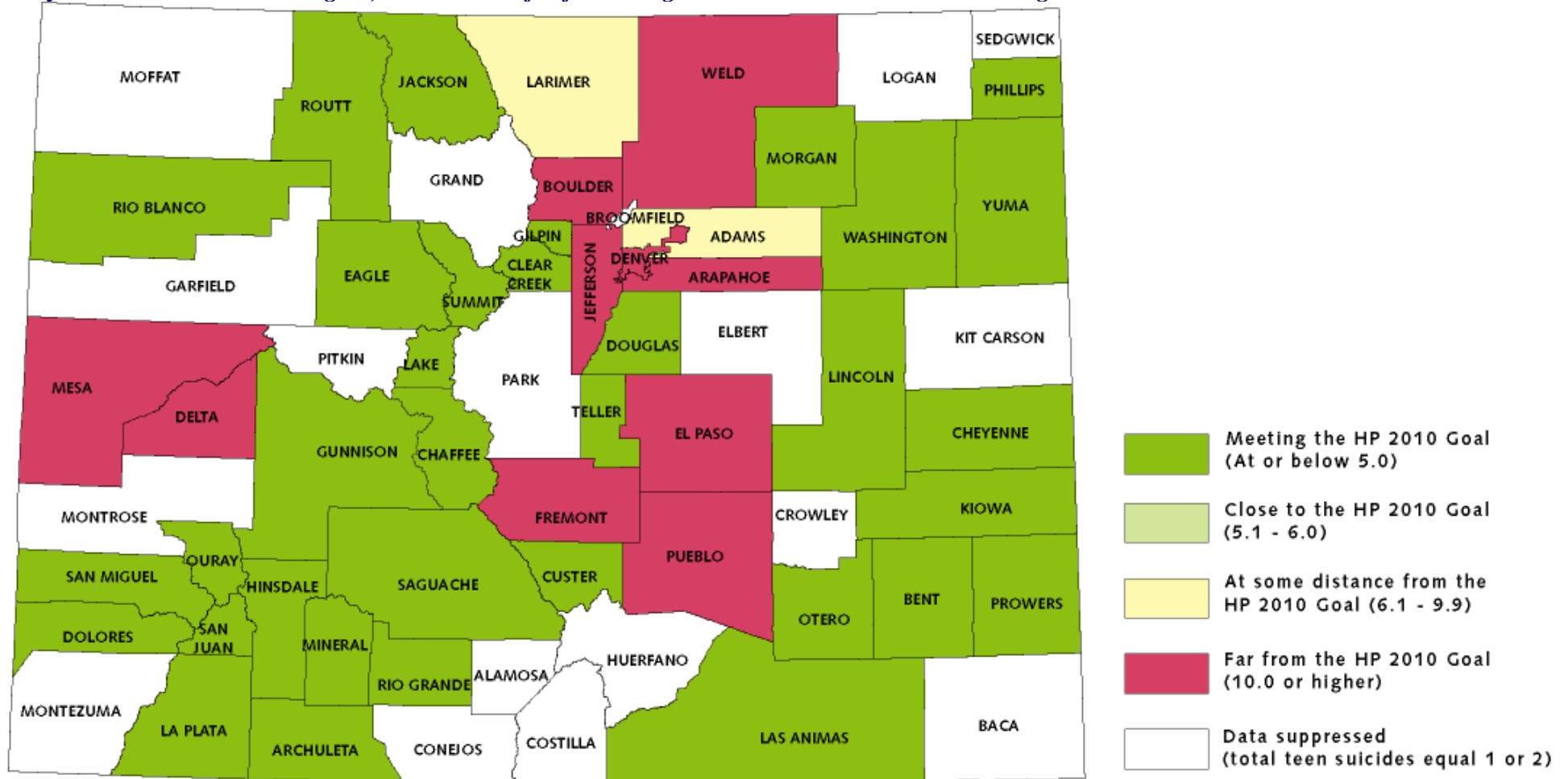


## Teen Suicide Rate State Performance Measure 16

**Healthy People 2010 Goal:** *Reduce suicides to no more than 5.0 per 100,000 youth aged 15-19.*

*County rates are 1999-2003 five-year averages, except for Broomfield which is 2002-2003 only. The state rate is 11.7.*

*Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.*
