
Very Low Birth Weight Rate National Performance Measure 15

Healthy People 2010 Goal: Reduce the very low birth weight rate to an incidence of no more than 0.9 percent of all births.

County rates are 2001-2003 three-year averages, except for Broomfield which is 2002-2003 only. The state rate is 1.3 percent.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
