

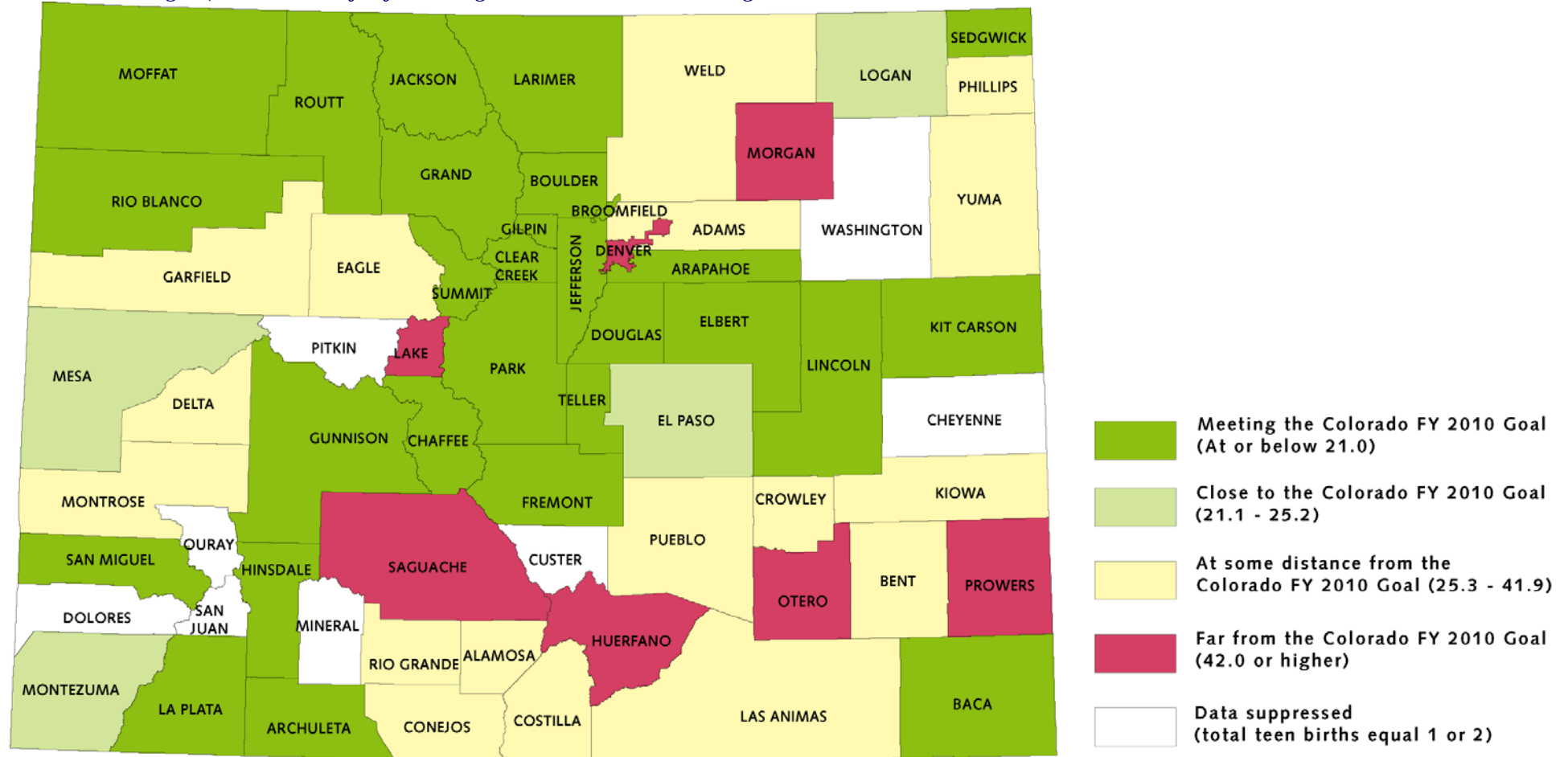
Teen Fertility Rate National Performance Measure 8
