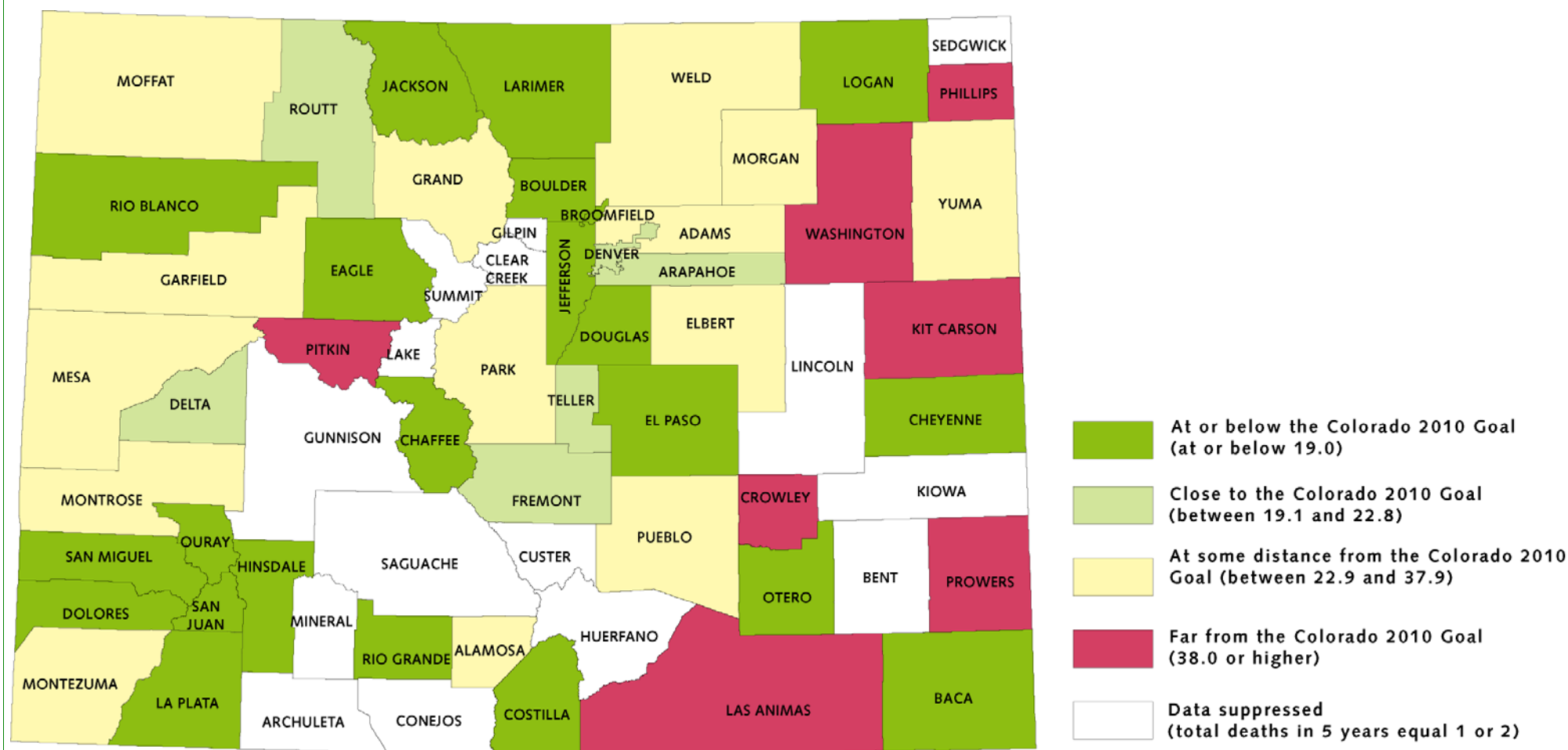


Child Death Rate age 1-14 National Outcome Measure 6

Colorado 2010 Goal: *Reduce the death rate of children to no more than 19.0 deaths per 100,000 children age 1-14.*

County rates are 2000-2004 five-year averages, except for Broomfield which is 2002-2004 only. The state rate is 20.3.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
