
Family Participation Degree National Performance Measure 2

Colorado FY 2010 Goal: To increase the degree to which the state assures family participation in program and policy activities in the state Children with Special Health Care Needs program.

Comparisons are based on the Colorado FY 2010 goal. Data are available for Fiscal Year 2005 for HCP (Health Care Program for Children with Special Needs) Regions, and are not available for most counties. Some regions have changed in composition from previous MCH County profile releases.

Regions categorized as close to the goal are within 80 percent of the goal; regions at some distance from the goal are between 51 percent and 79 percent of the goal; and regions far from the goal are 50 percent or less of the desired goal.
