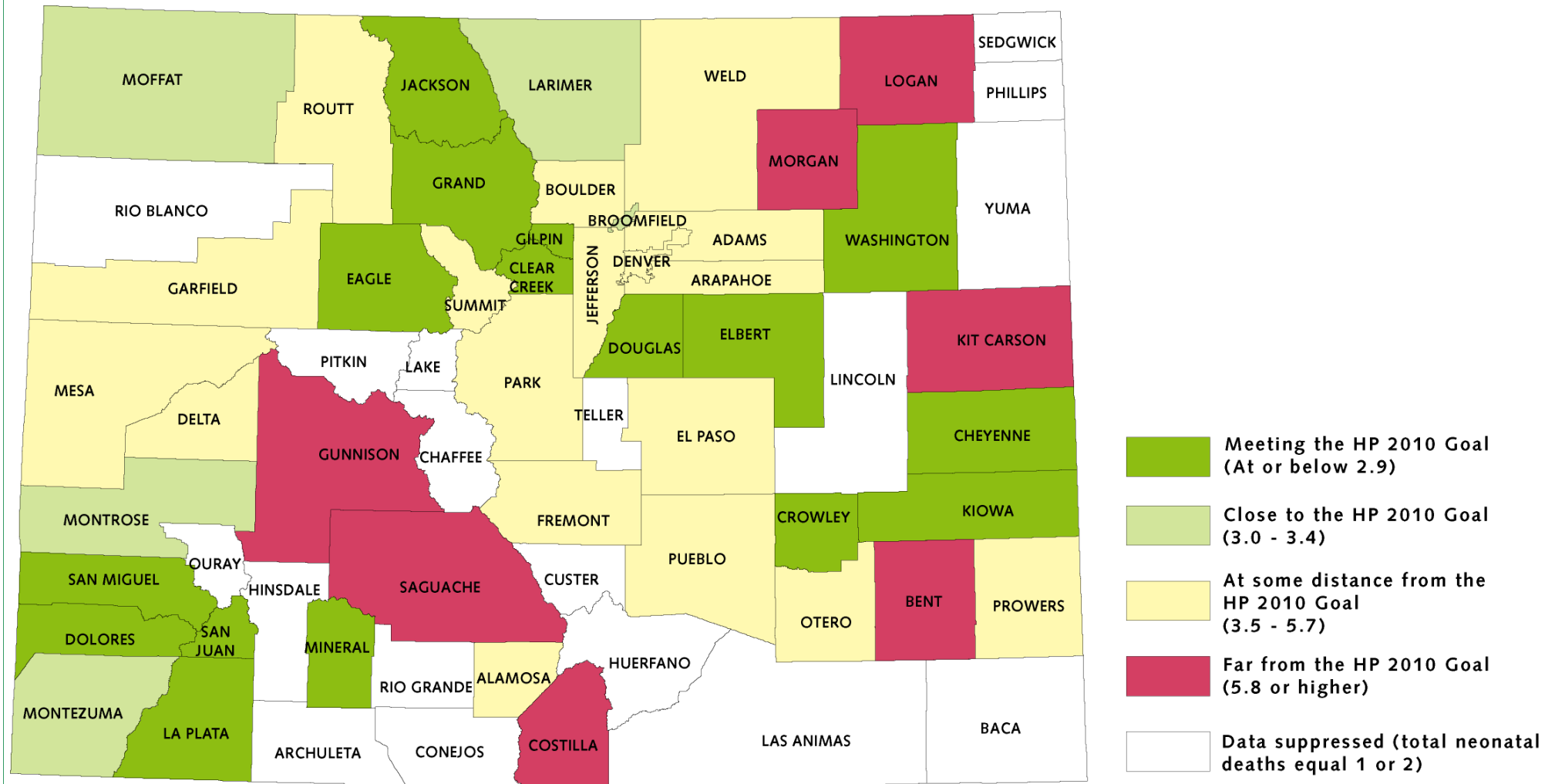


Neonatal Mortality Rate National Outcome Measure 3

Healthy People 2010 Goal: *Reduce the neonatal mortality rate to no more than 2.9 deaths per 1,000 births.*

County rates are 2000-2004 five-year averages, except for Broomfield which is 2002-2004 only. The state rate is 4.3.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
