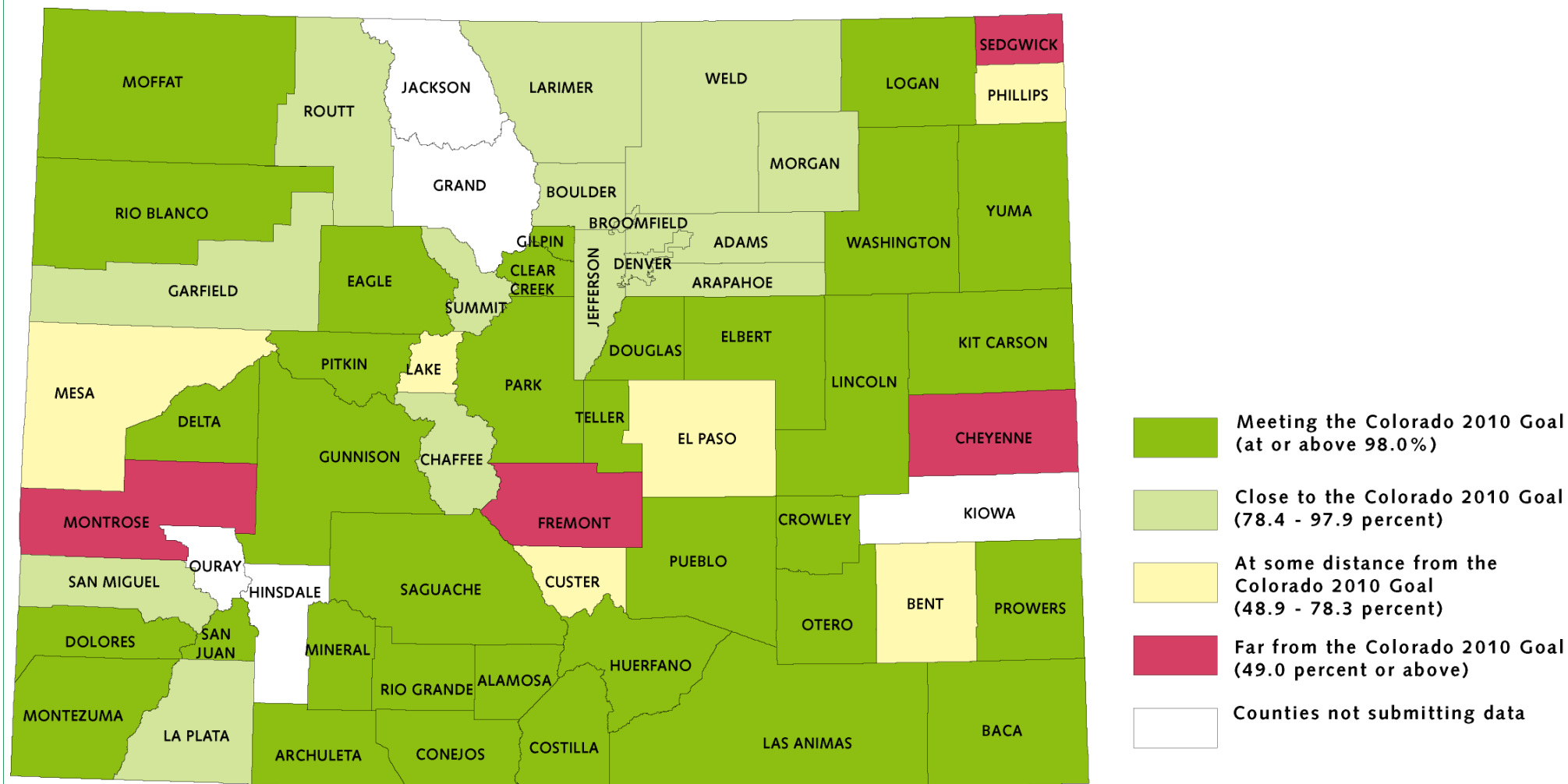


Child Care Centers Using Child Care Health Consultants (Percent) State Performance Measure 9

Colorado FY 2010 Goal: *Increase the percent of child care centers that use a child health care consultant to 98.0.*

County rates are based on Spring 2006 data. The Colorado rate is 88.6 percent.

Regions categorized as close to the goal are within 80 percent of the goal; regions at some distance from the goal are between 51 percent and 79 percent of the goal; and regions far from the goal are 50 percent or less of the desired goal.
