
Child Care Centers Using Child Care Health Consultants (Percent) State Performance Measure 9

Colorado FY 2010 Goal: Increase the percent of child care centers that use a child health care consultant to 98.0.

County rates are based on Spring 2006 data. The Colorado rate is 88.6 percent.
