
# Newborn Hearing Screening (Percent) National Performance Measure 12

Colorado FY 2010 Goal: Increase the percent of infants whose hearing is screened for impairment before hospital discharge to 98.0 percent.

County rates are for the year 2005 and are compared to the Colorado FY 2010 goal. The Colorado rate is 97.5 percent.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 90 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are between 51 percent and 89 percent of the goal; and counties far from the goal are 50 percent or less of the desired goal.
