
Low Birth Weight (Percent) State Outcome Measure 1

Healthy People 2010 Goal: Reduce the low birth weight rate to an incidence of no more than 5.0 percent of all births.

County rates are 2003-2005 three-year averages. The state rate is 9.1 percent.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
