
Untreated Decay (Estimated percent)

Healthy People 2010 Goal: Reduce the proportion of children with untreated dental decay in primary and permanent teeth to 21.0 percent or less.

County rates are estimated for the year 2004 and are compared to the Healthy People 2010 Goal. The Colorado rate is 26.0 percent.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are at least 20 percent away but are less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are double the goal.
