

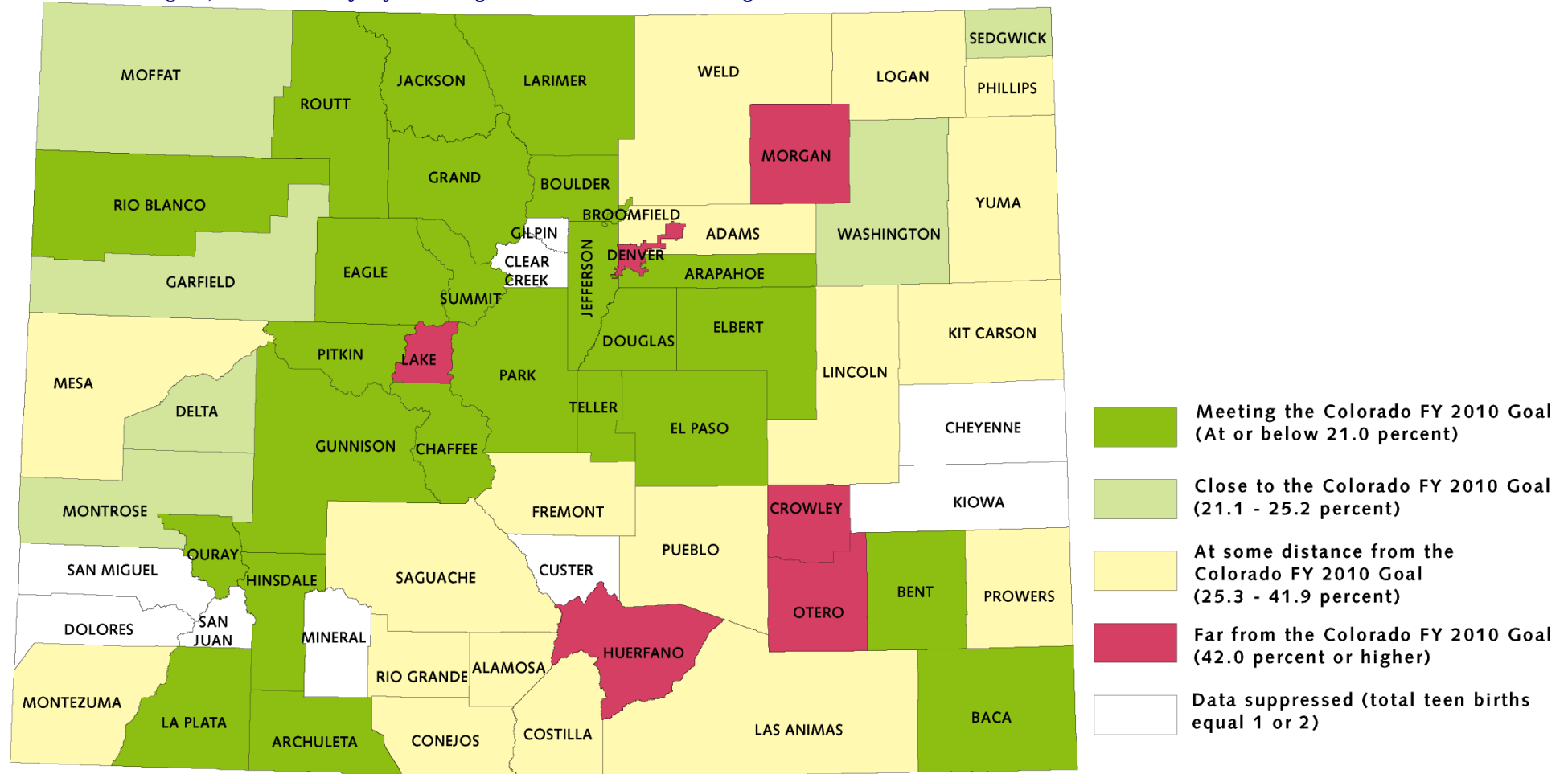
Teen Fertility 15-17

Healthy People 2010 Goal: *Reduce pregnancies among females age 15-17 to no more than 43 per 1,000 females.*

Colorado 2010 Goal: *Reduce the fertility rate among females age 15-17 to 21.0 births per 1,000 females.*

County rates are for 2004-2006 three-year averages. The state rate is 24.2. County comparisons are shown for the Colorado 2010 goal.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are double the desired goal.
