
Health Insurance Coverage (Estimated percent) National Performance Measure 13

Colorado 2010 Goal: Increase the percent of children ages 1-14 with any kind of health care coverage, including health insurance, prepaid plans, or government plans to 100%.

County rates are 2005-2006 two-year averages. The state rate is 88.0.
