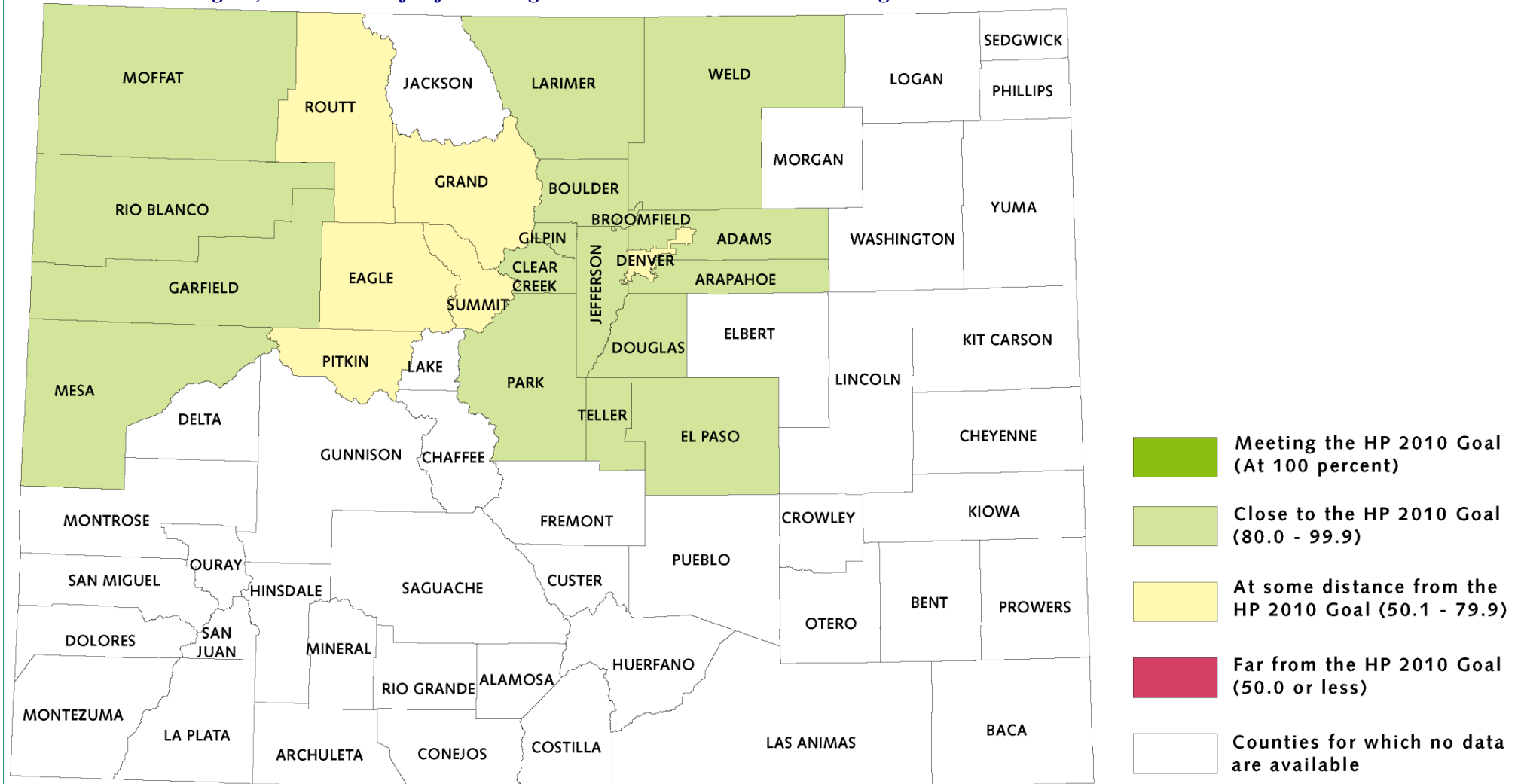


Health Insurance Coverage

Colorado 2010 Goal: *Increase the percent of children ages 1-14 with any kind of health care coverage, including health insurance, prepaid plans, or government plans to 100%.*

County rates are 2005-2006 two-year averages. The state rate is 88.0.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
