
Injury Hospitalizations 0-19 (Rate per 100,000)

Colorado 2010 Goal: Reduce the rate of injury hospitalization among children age 19 and younger to 230.0 per 100,000.

County rates are 2002-2006 five-year averages. The Colorado rate is 295.2.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
