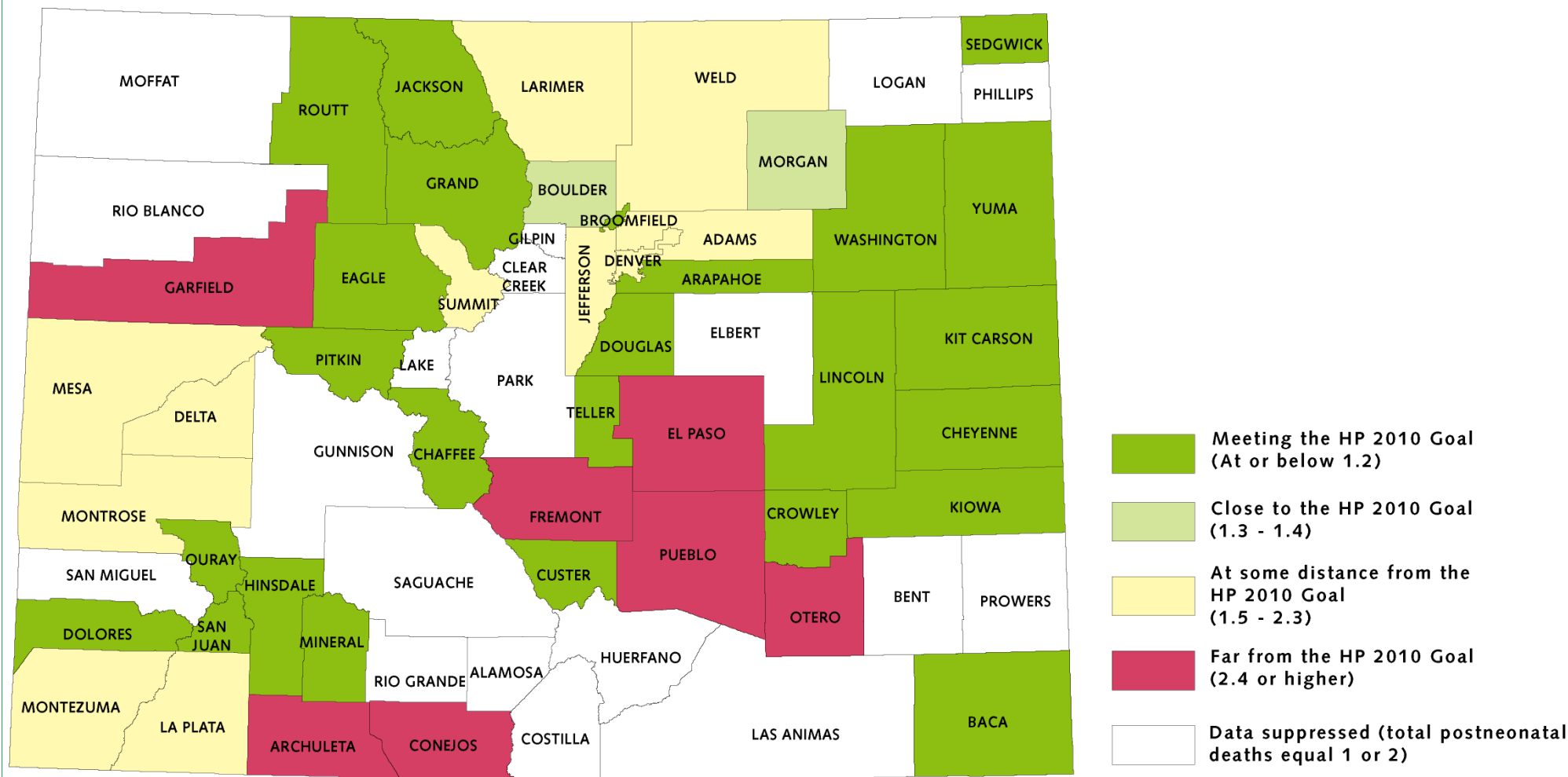


Postneonatal Mortality Rate (Rate per 1,000) National Outcome Measure 4

Healthy People 2010 Goal: *Reduce the postneonatal mortality rate to no more than 1.2 deaths per 1,000 births.*

County rates are 2002-2006 five-year averages. The state rate is 1.7.

Counties categorized as close to the goal are within 20 percent of the goal; counties at some distance from the goal are more than 20 percent away but less than double the goal; and counties far from the goal are at least double the desired goal.
