
Dental Sealants (Percent) National Performance Measure 9

Healthy People 2010 Goal: Increase the percent of children in grade three with a dental sealant on at least one tooth to 50.0 percent.

County rates are estimated for the 2006-2007 school year and are compared to the Healthy People 2010 Goal. The Colorado rate is 35.0 percent.
